

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR MANNER OF PLACING SOLID WASTES FOR PICKUP ON THE STREETS OR ALLEYS OF THE TOWN; REQUIRING REMOVAL OF SOLID WASTES FROM COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN SEVEN DAYS; PROHIBITING BURNING OF CERTAIN SOLID WASTES WITHIN THE TOWN AND PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS AND FOR PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Ennis:

1. That solid wastes to be disposed of within the Town of Ennis shall be placed upon the Streets or Alleys of the Town of Ennis for pick up by Town authorities or by Contractor authorized by said Town only in the following condition:

A. ~~metal~~ cans and loose refuse items shall be placed in metal or plastic cans or containers of not more than thirty-five gallon capacity.

B. Loose items such as leaves, limbs, wire, newspapers, magazines, shall in all cases be bagged, boxed or bundled in packages not exceeding eighty pounds in weight.

2. All solid wastes, refuse or garbage emanating from or produced as a result of activities in any commercial establishment shall be removed from the open areas adjacent to any such establishment at least once a week and shall not be permitted to be in open areas within the Town for in excess of seven days.

3. No person, firm, corporation or other entity shall burn, incinerate or otherwise cause to be consumed by fire any trash, refuse, leaves or grass clippings within the limits of the Town of Ennis in any open barrel or container or in the open without specific permit therefor signed by the Mayor; provided that such limitation shall not prohibit burning in indoor fireplaces or stoves or indoor trash burner nor shall the same prohibit outdoor cooking in outdoor fireplaces, stoves or properly contained receptacles.

4. Any person convicted of disposing of waste or otherwise handling solid waste in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than \$ 50.⁰⁰.
