

ORDINANCE NO. 98

An Ordinance amending Section 10.14.020 of the Ennis Town Code to read as follows:

Motor vehicles shall, on all streets within the Town, be parked parallel with the edge of the curb of said street within two feet (2') of said edge or curb, except as noted herein:

- (A) Motor vehicles on Main Street, North First Street and North Third Street, shall be diagonally parked in accordance with the markings placed upon those streets by the Town.
