FIRE SITUATION: Yesterday, at 10:00 AM management of the fire was transferred to the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation County Assist Team. Resources built and improved fire line; monitored for hot spots; conducted a burn operation and mopped-up, where possible.

Today, resources will continue to build and improve fire line, monitor for hot spots and mop-up. The weather may include thunderstorms capable of producing erratic, gusty winds but moderate fire behavior and minimal chance of spread outside containments is expected.

DNRC County Assist Team Incident Commander David Hamilton and Incident Commander trainee Patrick Lonergan are managing the fire while working closely with local landowners, Madison County, Montana State University, and interagency fire cooperators.
