Vote to approve the 1st reading of the Zone Setback Amendments to the Zoning Code for the Town of Ennis.

Palmerton makes motion to approve 1st reading. Ranson seconds. Mayor calls to vote. All vote yes.

Discussion/review with Great West Engineering on the Town of Ennis infrastructure including but not limited to water, sewer and streets. Discussion to include financial responsibilities (i.e. grants) for infrastructure projects.

Collette Anderson introduces herself. Reviews meeting discussions in December 2021. Great West recommends expanding on wells that were dug out near Rodeo Grounds and states they are waiting on quotes from drillers to move forward with that process. Discussion on increasing water rates in order for Town to be eligible for grant opportunities. Recommends pretreatment for RV parks or other industrial use facilities. Collette to prepare and bring contract for water and wastewater at February 10 meeting. Discussion on updating the Emergency Preparedness System. Recommends keeping Capital Improvement Projects updated regularly with budgeting process. Discussion on streets and street standards.

Discussion on public meeting policy. Review of draft.

Bancroft moved to adjourn. Ranson seconds. All vote yes.
