**UPDATE – Boil Order
Water Main Maintenance
*Repairs Underway***

June 2nd, 2022, 1115 hours

Due to the severity of the water main break and out of abundance of caution a Boil Order for all consumed water has been issued for the residents affected only by the water service disruption.

The areas affected are Steffens Street south and South First Street east. This will include the streets of: East Steffens Street, East Ennis Street, East Hugel Street, East Fagin Street, Riverview Dr, East Armitage Street, South Second Street, East Grizzly Street, Rodeo Drive, Jefferson Street, and Passamari Street.

The Boil Order will remain in place until water samples are tested, and the water is deemed safe by the Montana DEQ. The water can be used for bathing, dishwashing (by dishwasher only) and laundry. If the water is consumed it must be boiled first.

Ennis Public Works is making progress on the water main repair. Pressure testing is currently underway to the damaged water main. Crews will continue with repairs and service is expected to be restored by 6pm June 2nd, 2022.
