# MONTHLY LAW ENFORCEMENT REPORT TO THE ENNIS TOWN COMMISSION

Regular Commission meeting October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Officer Fisher has completed his 1-year probationary period and his paperwork has been submitted to Montana Police Officer Standards and Training for his Basic Peace Officer Certification. For those of you who have not met (either formally or informally) Officer Fisher, we will be attending the October Commission Meeting to formally introduce him.

Officer Fisher has also successfully completed the Montana Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Training. Another word that is nationally used, but not completely accurate for CIT training is "de-escalation". CIT's purpose is to assist first responders, law enforcement officers, detention staff, and dispatchers in engaging, assessing, and assisting individuals in crisis with mental and/or co-occurring substance disorders. CIT is a 40-hour evidence-based training that encompasses tools and skills needed for first responders, detention staff, and dispatchers to better manage individuals presenting with mental health and/or co-occurring substance disorders. This training exposes the participants to materials and experiences from trained mental health and medical professionals to better prepare them to effectively and safely work with this unique population. Both Officer Fisher and I are Montana CIT trained.

The West Main Street sign is now working correctly, thanks to Public Works for taking the sign down so it could be reset and then putting it back up. Windows 10 continues to be a battle with the Bluetooth connection and downloading the speed signs. Sooner or later a work around will be released from Windows or TrafficLogix to get our Bluetooth connection working again and the speed sign reports will continue.
