**Water Main Break Affects Town of Ennis Residents
*Boil Water Advisory Has Been Lifted***

April 15th 2023 10:45am Water Service has been restored to all affected customers. DEQ Boil Water Advisory Has Been Lifted

Montana DEQ informed the Town of Ennis after five bacteriological samples taken 4/14/2023 showed satisfactory results the Boil Water Advisory Has Been Lifted.

Beginning Monday April 17th, 2023 roadwork will resume in downtown Ennis to inspect and repair the north side of the road damaged by the water main break.

NO PARKING will be permitted from Monday April 17th, 2023 at 3am on East Main Street where the existing traffic cones were located until the project is completed. East Main Street (US287) will once again be restricted to one lane with traffic control devices while the work is being completed. Please slow down, have patience, and drive cautiously around the workers.

Water pickup is cancelled.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Boil Water Advisory Has Been Lifted for The Town of Ennis MT0000208

Our water system experienced a water main break which could have resulted in contamination of the water supply. Because of the loss of pressure, it was unknown if contaminants could have infiltrated the distribution system. Five bacteriological samples taken **4/14/2023** showed satisfactory results and repairs were completed along with disinfection and flushing.

This **Boil Water Advisory has been lifted**. The Town of Ennis public water supply had experienced a loss of pressure due to a water main break. Water system personnel worked diligently to get the water main repaired and disinfected.

What should I do?

Return to normal use.

What is being done?

Bacteriological samples of the water were collected on 4/14/2023 and have satisfactory results.
