The presentation will cover various aspects, including facts about smartphones, insights into the ICAC Task Force and its operations, information about sextortion, the utilization of artificial intelligence on the internet, red flags to watch for when children interact with strangers online, and steps to take if a child encounters an issue.

The Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program (ICAC program) assists state and local law enforcement agencies in developing effective responses to technology-facilitated child sexual exploitation and internet crimes against children. This assistance includes forensic and investigative support, training, technical assistance, victim services, and community education.

The ICAC program was established in 1998 in response to the escalating use of the internet by children and teenagers, the proliferation of online images depicting child sexual abuse, and the increasing online activity of individuals seeking to exploit children and teenagers.
