The 1972 Montana State Constitution ensures Montana residents have the option of a local government review every 10 years.

70% of Ennis voters on the June 2024 ballot approved conducting this review.

Current form of government for Town of Ennis: **Charter form with Commission-Executive (Mayor) structure**

- Commission
- Charter

The Study Commission will take the results of this survey, along with other data and input gathered, to determine if the current form of government is sufficient or if another form would be better suited for the management and success of providing services to the citizens of our town. Our recommendation will be presented to the Town Commission for approval. If approved, any ballot measures will be up to the Ennis voters in November 2025.
